ICAO 051 ATC BASIC

Course Summary

The Basic Course follows the ICAO syllabus, with appropriate elements of the European Common Core Content as required and meets the requirements and objectives for the ICAO 051 course.

A competency certificate will be awarded on successful completion of the course.

Entry Criteria

All entrants must:

- Have a minimum English language proficiency of ICAO Level 4.
- Students must be at least 18 years old on completion or as determined by the National Aviation Authority / Client.
- Students must have a valid Class 3 equivalent Medical issued by an approved Aviation Medical Examiner (AME).

- Air Traffic Management
- Navigation
- Meteorology
- Equipment and Systems.
- Principles of Flight, Aircraft Performance and Recognition.
- Human Factors.
- Professional Environment.
